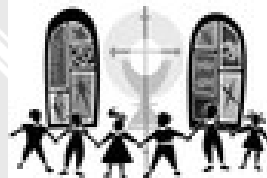


to the Friday Lenten dinners which have been spearheaded by our FS, Tom Lavellee and his

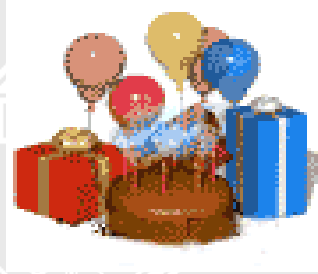

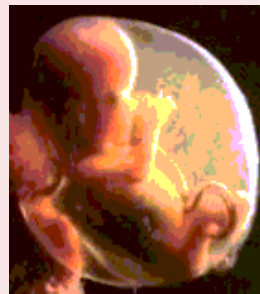
